## **IEEE E-TEMS 2022 has 3 different presentation types of papers**

### **FOR PRESENTERS:**

#### **Oral Presentation**

Join the session where you are presenting by clicking on "Join live now" button and you will be redirected to the virtual room. During the session, you will be asked to switch on your camera and <u>share your screen</u> in order to show your slides.

Time devoted to oral presentation is limited by max 15 minutes, Q&A part will be at the end of your session, therefore, you should be present the whole session online.

### **Posters & Videos**

All posters and videos are available already on the portal. Everyone can check them prior to the Poster and Video Discussions.

During the <u>whole</u> **Poster & Video Discussions session,** the author (representative) must be present to discuss your paper(s). At some point of time the moderators will announce your paper and ask you some questions about it

### **Posters and Videos**

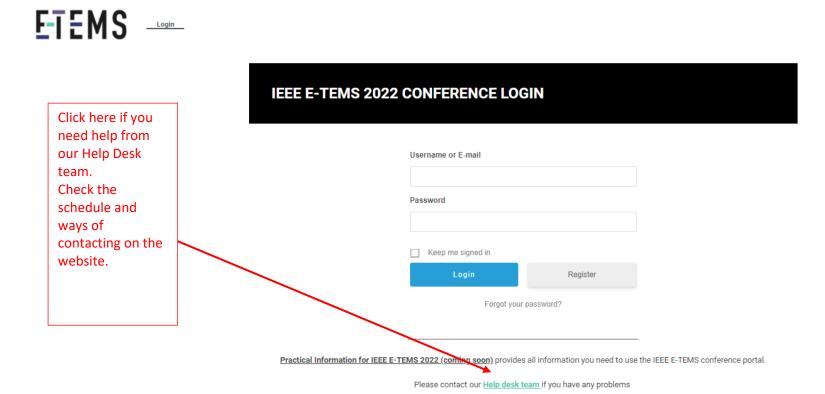

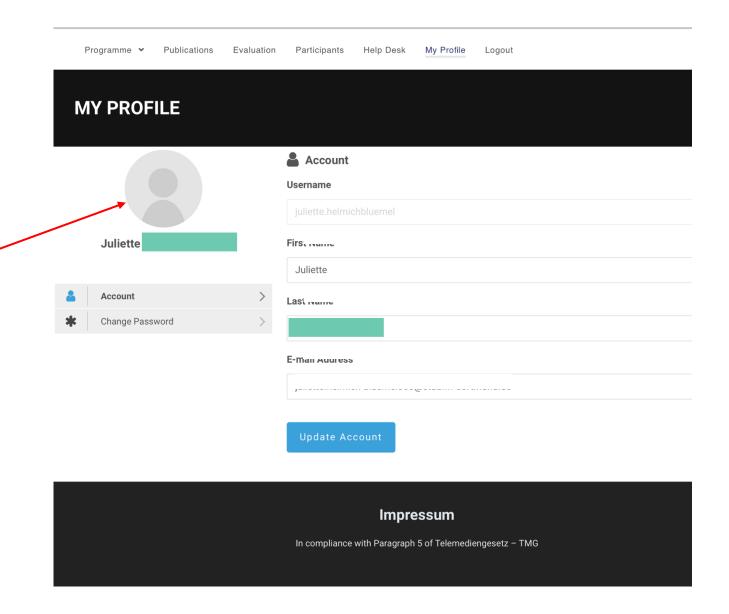

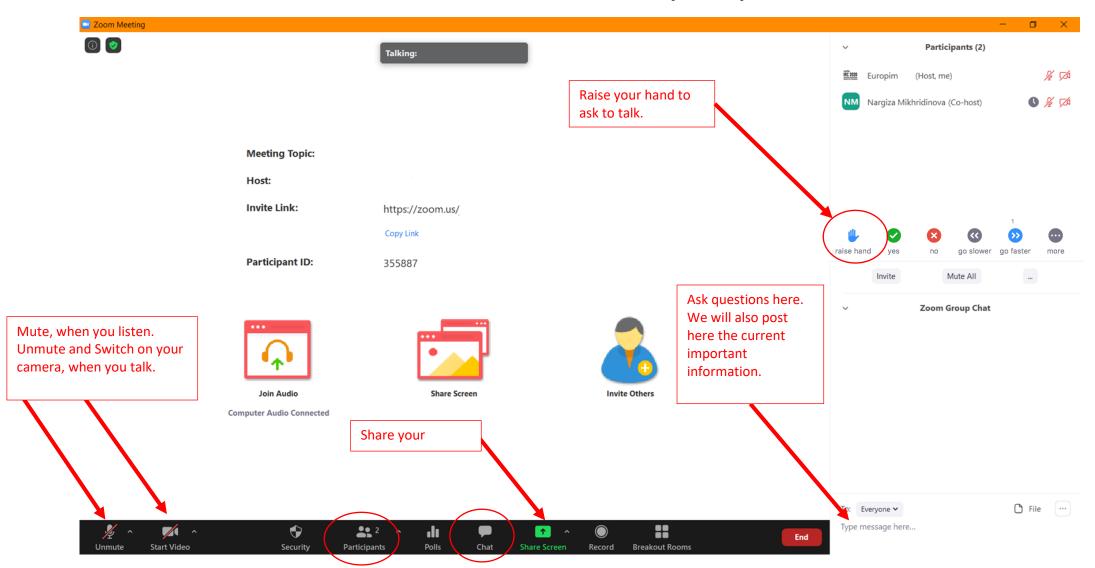
